## BUSY BEE'S

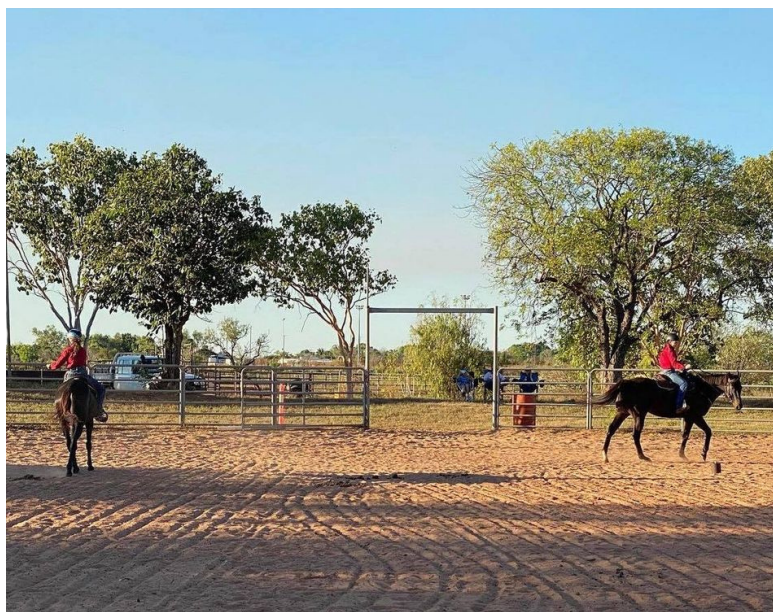
