It's been a wet end to the month! Grazing paddocks are now closed. Please keep the following wet season rules in mind:

- Arenas & Round yards are closed when there is standing water. Please use your best judgement.
- Grazing paddocks closed until further notice from the committee
- Be mindful of the trenches from the recent plumbing upgrade as they're sinking! Please back-fill when you can and ask for help with the Kubota if needed once it dries up a little.
- Please only drive through the grounds if you need to as it's sloppy.
- Exercising your horse: Walking only throughout the grounds except in arenas, roundyards and the track around campdraft arena. Absolutely no horses any time in the spectator area around the main arena.
- As yards begin to flood please check with your neighbours if they need help. Please feel free to move your horse to dryer water yards/campdraft holding yards or a friendly neighbours yard.


THINGS TO KEEP IN MIND:




ARENA? CLOSE IT

An Exercise in Straitness & Rhythm



How to Ride:

Through the channel without passing over any poles. Then try making a transition in the middle of the channel.

Diagonally across the "3 sided box" at the canter.

Through the "3 sided box" try using the single straight pole to a downward/upward gait transition.

Over all three poles in trot keep the rhythm: 1 trot stride space followed by 2 trot stride spaces.

Over all three poles in trot, then gait transition between poles 2&3.

ANDY LOCKYER WILL BE OUT AND ABOUT COMPLETING A NUMBER OF PROJECTS NOTED BELOW!

1. REPLACING TESSA & CHRIS' FRONT FENCE
2. RE-WIRE KERRY'S FENCE & HANG GATE NEAR MANURE PILE
3. VET CRUSH - NEW ADJUSTABLE GATE INSTALL
4. GATE ON MIDDLE PADDOCK TO OPEN BOTH WAYS
5. FRONT FENCE LINE (ALONG ROAD) RE-WIRE LOOSE WIRE
6. RE HANG WING GATE NEAR ELLIE'S YARD & CANTEEN TO BLOCK OFF AGISTMENT ROAD WHEN REQUIRED.
7. BUILD A SOLID SHADE STRUCTURE NEAR CLUB HOUSE IN RODEO ARENA SPECTATOR AREA.
8. INSTALL A SOLID SHADE ABOVE FARRIER'S BAY & VET CRUSH (APPROX 4M WIDE X 7M LONG X 3M HIGH)
