# Around the Grounds



- Please regularly empty and clean your water troughs and buckets to reduce mosquito breeding!
- The farrier will be around the grounds starting the 20th September. Please liaise with BJ if you forgot your time (too late to register interest). **YOU MUST BE ON TIME! IF YOU CANNOT MAKE IT PLEASE ASK FOR HELP!**
- **NO FREE GRAZING ALLOWED!** Horses must be tied up or physically held (lead rope in your closed hand) at all times. No exceptions.
- **REMEMBER TO TIGHTEN LOOSE FENCE WIRES!** Loose or broken wires are a hazard to your horse and others!

## FROM THE WATER CORP REGARDING ROADSIDE WORKS:

This week a surveyor will survey the road reserve adjacent to your property. They will not need to enter your property to undertake the survey.

Local construction company Kimberley Civil and Drainage will start work in the road reserve of Broome Road adjacent to Broome Horse Riders' Club in approximately three to four weeks' time.

The work will involve heavy equipment excavating a trench and the installation of a wastewater pipeline. It is likely that the construction crew will be in the area for up to two months. We will keep access to your property open.

Unfortunately, the work will be noisy. If there is anything that we can do to reduce the impacts of the works on your business, please let me know at your earliest convenience.

# Have some spare time? Or Haven't made it to a Busy Bee?

Please consider getting your hands dirty when you have some spare time!

- 15 to 20 minutes? Go cut some weed trees and weeds! There are neem trees, leuceana, and kings crown along the fence lines, common areas & in the paddocks that can be cut with nippers and poisoned (all available for member use, just ask!).
- 15-20 minutes - Go around and water the jígal trees around the grounds in front of campdraft, to the left of the middle paddock gate, and around the large roundyard! Also marul trees to the left of the main campdraft arena gate.
- 30-45 minutes: finish hanging the front fence signs! Gear for all this is ready to go we just need someone to go for it!
- 1hr + Put star picket caps on the middle paddock and/or campdraft paddock arena! Caps are in the freezer inside the first door of the red donga at the entrance of the grounds
- Have your kubota approval? Rake the arenas!
